(contd .. page 1) Dynastic ownership can be justified in the case of companies, but management at the dynastic level sometimes proves fatal for the company and its employees, he said. He also exhorted SIDM to create an independent body, comprising scientists and experts from the industry, which will work with transparency and evaluate the products made by the companies. “The buyer or the government will definitely try to check the quality of the products from their end, but there is a need to develop a system for internal evaluation as well. This quality check system will increase your credibility globally with time,” he said. The Minister also suggested SIDM create an internal vigilance mechanism to counter the potential cases of corruption and favoritism. “If any company affiliated with you is indulging in any wrongdoing or passing wrong information, then you should bring it before the government. Such actions will further increase people’s trust in the institutions,” he said. The Minister listed out the steps taken by the Government, led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, to support the domestic industry, such as ensuring demand assurance as well as rolling out the transfer of technology policy of DRDO. He added that the synergy between the government and the domestic companies has resulted in record defence production of Rs one lakh crore and exports of Rs 16,000 crore in Financial Year 2023-24. He expressed confidence that the defence exports will soon touch the Rs 20,000 crore mark and extended Ministry of Defence’s continued support to the industry to ensure their as well as holistic development of the nation, in line with the ‘Aatmanirbhar Bharat’ initiative. The North Tech symposium is an event conducted annually and this year it was organised at IIT, Jammu. The event witnessed an enthusiastic participation of around 200 Industry partners and provided an opportunity for knowledge diffusion among various stakeholders to create awareness of contemporary technologies and hardware solutions available with the manufacturers under ‘Aatmanirbhar Bharat’. Validity of sedition law: SC refers pleas to 5-judge larger Constitution bench

(contd ... page 1) The Apex Court also took into record the submissions and arguments by the AG and SG that, at this stage, it was appropriate to defer reference to the five-judge bench having regard to the fact that parliament is in the process of reenacting the law. The court, however, in its order, said that we are not inclined to defer the consideration. The Attorney General (AG) of India, R Venkataramani, the top law officer representing the Union of India, argued that the new law is there and has been sent to a parliamentary standing committee. "The parliamentary standing committee is looking into it," Venkataramani said. Senior lawyer Kapil Sibal, for one of the petitioners, opposed it and told the Top Indian Court that the new law is much worse and the prosecutions will go on. He said in 1973, this section 124-A was made a cognisable offence. Prior to that, it wasn't cognisable. Therefore, they started arresting people invoking this section. Sibal, while narrating Section 124-A, said , "disaffection towards the government". As far as 19(1)(a) [Right to freedom of speech and expression], is concerned, it refers to "state", not government. "What is fundamentally wrong is disaffection towards the government is not disaffection towards the state; the state is not the government, and the government is not the state," Sibal said. We have to decide on this law as it stands today. We can't wait for the parliament to decide on this, Sibal said. To this, the Solicitor General (SG) Tushar Mehta argued that, at the highest level, it was being seriously considered. And it is done now. But the government stated that let all parties be referred to in this context; let us wait for the government. It is at the highest level of being reconsidered; it has now been reconsidered. Elevated walkways for to over come Human-Animal Conflict in The long Run-Wildlife Chief warden of AP

TIRUMALA, 12 SEPTEMBER 2023: The intention of both the State Government and TTD is to make the footpath routes to Tirumala safe zones for pedestrian pilgrims and at the same time protecting the interest of wildlife, said the Wildlife Chief Warden of Andhra Pradesh, Sri Y Madhusudhan Reddy. Speaking to media persons at Annamaiah Bhavan in Tirumala on Tuesday, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests [WL] said, he had discussed in length with the TTD EO Sri AV Dharma Reddy about the short-term and long-term plans to overcome the Human-Animal conflict

in the Tirumala footpath routes and ghat roads. Elaborating further he said, after the leopard attack on Lakshita, a six-year-old girl, both the forest and TTD have spruced up the measures along the footpath routes and especially in the Alipiri Footpath route in a big way. “We have placed 20 hi-fi real time cameras and another 300 camera traps all along the Seventh mile and Sri Lakshmi Narasimha Swamy temple and caught hold of five leopards and shifted them to SV Zoo Park. Also procuring 500 nos. advanced sim based real time camera traps. Due to several food establishments along the Alipiri footpath route, the animals like



deer, wild pigs, dogs are coming for these food wastes which are in turn prompting the wild cats and other beasts like sloth bear. So restrictions were imposed on eateries. Joint measures like sending the pilgrims in a troupe of 100 with security guards, allowing children to walk along footpath only upto 2pm, movement of two wheel-

ers along ghat roads from 6am to 6pm will continue till the things turn to normalcy”, he added. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests also said, as a long term measure “Elevated Walkways” have been suggested. The Seshachala Ranges are a treasure house of flora and fauna and rich scenic beauty. These walkways not only enable the pedestrian walkers to experience the natural beauties but also provide free passage to wildlife without obstructing their natural movements”, he further added. Chief Conservator of Forests Sri Nageswara Rao, Deputy CF of TTD Sri Srinivasulu were also present.

Farooq slams Modi govt for reducing additional duties on US apples



Srinagar, Sep 12 (UNI) National Conference president Farooq Abdullah on Tuesday slammed the union government for the tax waiver on several United States products including apples, and walnuts and threatened to hit the streets if it is not rolled back. “When the concessions were announced during the G20, it wasn't thought what impact it would have on our economy. Not only J&K but it will also affect Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand,” Abdullah said here. Last week the

Union Finance Ministry, in a notification announced the removal of additional duties on several US products including chickpeas, lentils (masur), apples, walnuts in shells, and fresh or dried almonds, as well as shelled almonds. The notification came a day before US President Joe Biden's arrival in India for the G20 Summit. Abdullah alleged the Union government to appease the US wanted to finish the local growers “Horticulture is the major economy of J&K. To appease the US, they

want to finish the local growers. I appeal to the Government of India to not take a step that would increase the poverty that is already here and we get stuck in another crisis...If they don't make it easy for the people, we will take to the street and protest," the Member of Parliament said. PDP president Mehbooba Mufti, who on Monday urged the Prime Minister to reconsider the decision, on Tuesday alleged that the move was aimed at destroying J&K economy.

ACB court rejects Chandrababu Naidu's house remand petition

(contd ... page 1) However, the AP CID has filed a counter objecting to this request. Chandrababu's lawyer Siddharth Luthra said there was a threat to Chandrababu's life. He said Chandrababu's NSG security, VVIP status, 73-year-old age and health should be taken into consideration to allow his petition for the house remand petition. He also referred to the case in which the Supreme Court allowed 'house arrest' of human rights activist Gautam Navlakha, who is an accused in the 2018 Bhima Koregaon violence case. The additional advocate general of the State P. Sudhakar Reddy, who argued the case on behalf of the CID, made it clear there was no threat to Chandrababu in Rajahmundry Central Jail. He said Naidu was under full security. “A separate room in the jail, home food, medicines and a personal assistant have been provided and if Chandrababu is outside, there is a possibility of influencing the witnesses. The house arrest petition does not deserve a hearing,” Sudhakar Reddy argued and urged the court to reject the petition. Vijayawada ACB court judge heard the arguments of both the parties and agreed with the CID's arguments. Speaking to media persons later, Reddy said there were only two types of custodies in the CrPC and added that they were judicial and police custodies while noting that there is no house arrest provision in the criminal procedure code. “All are equal before the law. Chandrababu has full security. Rajahmundry jail has high security. Can we expect so much security in a private house? Moreover, the court has given permission to send food from home for Chandrababu. We have considered Chandrababu's requests. No one goes to their block without Babu's permission. The doctors will be there to monitor Babu's health,” he said. Commenting on the absence of Naidu's name in the FIR of the case, he said if there is no name in the FIR, it does not mean that no mistake had been made. He said Chandrababu's role was revealed in the scam in the investigation of the CID.
