Inflation cools to 2.75% as govt overhauls index

Veg prices tumble under new CPI series with 2023-2024 as base year

RETAIL inflation eased to 2.75% year-on-year in January, helped largely by a sharp fall in prices of key vegetables and pulses, even as jewellery and select food items registered price rise, government data released on Wednesday showed.

The latest inflation print also marks the first release of the Consumer Price Index with a revised base year of 2023-2024, replacing the 2011-12 series.

The revision, based on the Household Consumption Expenditure Survey 2023-24, expands the basket to reflect current consumption patterns, especially the growing role of services and digital spending.

The data, released by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, showed that inflation in rural areas stood at 2.7% while urban inflation was marginally higher at 2.77%. Food inflation, measured by the Consumer Food Price Index, was 2.13%.

A steep fall in prices of essential kitchen staples played a major role in keeping headline inflation contained. Garlic

prices fell 53.05%, onion 29.27%, potato 28.98%, arhar (tur) dal 24.90% and peas slipped 15.56% on an annual basis.

At the same time, some items witnessed extraordinary inflation. Silver jewellery soared 159.67%, tomato prices 64.80%, copra 47%, gold, diamond and platinum jewellery 46.77%, and coconut oil shot up 40.44%.

The revised series expands the basket from 299 items to 358. Rural house rent has been

included, as have modern consumption elements such as OTT subscriptions, online services, and CNG/PNG. Outdated items like VCRs and cassette players have been removed.

The updated series also incorporates e-commerce prices in 12 major cities.

"New items have been added to capture changes in the economy and consumer behaviour," MoSPI secretary Saurabh Garg recently told this newspaper.

Textiles to get benefits on par with Dhaka in final deal: Govt

INDIA, like Bangladesh, will receive the benefit of zero-duty access to the US market for garments made using US-origin cotton and man-made fibres under the proposed India-US trade agreement, Commerce Minister Piyush Goyal said on Thursday.

"In the final agreement, India will also get what Bangladesh received under the yarn-forward and cotton-forward provisions. If specific cotton or yarn is imported from the US, processed in India, and exported back to the US, it will receive the same benefit as Bangladesh," Goyal said.

The clarification comes amid concerns that Indian exporters could lose their competitive edge to Bangladesh in the US market following the US-Bangladesh trade deal announced on February 9. Under that deal, the US agreed to zero-duty entry for garments made with US-origin cotton and man-made fibres, triggering uncertainty within India's textile export community.

Leader of Opposition Rahul Gandhi had on Wednesday cautioned that if Bangladesh imports US cotton at zero duty, it would further weaken India's competitiveness, potentially devastating the domestic textile sector.

Following these developments, garment exporters from across the country met Goyal. The minister, however, assured that "textile exporters would derive maximum benefit from the proposed deal."

Counting begins after peaceful B'desh polls

Yunus call to uphold democratic decency

"I call upon political parties and candidates to uphold democratic decency, tolerance and mutual respect even after the final results are announced. Differences of opinion will exist, but in the national interest, we must remain united," Chief Adviser Muhammad Yunus said

COUNTING of votes began in Bangladesh on Thursday evening after peaceful polling earlier in the day for the crucial general elections to elect Parliament members and decide on a referendum on constitutional reforms. While the interim government and the election commission hailed the process, deposed prime minister Sheikh Hasina called the polls "a well-planned farce" and demanded a "free, fair and inclusive elections under a neutral caretaker government".

At the time of going to the press, there was no official word on the polling percentage, though the poll rolls had nearly 13 crore voters. What was visible though was a good turnout in the morning, but no subsequent voter rush at polling booths for the rest of the day. People just came in ones and twos to cast their ballots.

Without going into the numbers, the election commission claimed the turnout was satisfactory.

This is a straight fight between the Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) led by Tarique Rahman, 60, and an 11-party alliance led by the Bangladesh Jamaat e Islami and the nascent National Citizen Party (NCP). As per initial trends, BNP candidates appeared to be leading the race with Jamaat struggling to put up a decent show. In the early rounds of counting for the referendum, negative votes were more than the 'yes' votes.

Top BNP and Jamaat and NCP leaders said they would accept the verdict if the process is not rigged. CONTINUED ON: P9

Govt green light to procure 114 Rafales

AHEAD of French President Emmanuel Macron's visit to India next week, the defence ministry on Thursday accorded acceptance of necessity (AoN) for capital acquisition proposals worth around ₹3.6 lakh crore, including the much awaited government-to-government deal for 114 Rafale multi-role fighter aircraft estimated at about ₹3.25 lakh crore.

The final contract for the jets is unlikely to be signed before early 2027, sources said.

The AoN marks the first formal step in the procurement process, after which commercial negotiations and contract finalisation follow. The time-

line for conclusion varies depending on the negotiations. Under the proposal, the Indian Air Force is expected to receive 88 single-seat and 26 twin-seat Rafale fighters. Around 18 aircraft are likely to be delivered in fly-away condition, while the remaining 96 will be manufactured in India with up to 60 per cent indigenous content.

Sources said the overall Rafale package includes an estimated ₹2.5 lakh crore for the aircraft and associated systems, with weapons and support elements taking the total value to around ₹3.25 lakh crore. This includes procurement of 100-120 SCALP air-launched cruise missiles, for



More anti-submarine P-8Is for Navy cleared

New Delhi: The DAC also approved the acquisition of six more P-8I long-range reconnaissance and anti-submarine warfare aircraft for the Indian Navy, for ₹28,000 crore, to strengthen surveillance

₹2,700 crore. The missile was used during Operation Sindoor to strike targets in Bahawalpur and Muridke in the early hours of May 7.

The contract will incorporate provisions for upgrading

Indian Rafales to the future F5 standard once available, while the existing fleet would be brought up to the F4 configuration, which includes enhanced sensor fusion, improved connectivity and expanded weapons capability.

The DAC also approved procurement of additional long-range surface-to-air missiles for Project Sudarshan Chakra. The proposal pertains to replenishment of missile stocks for the S-400 air defence system, with around 280 missiles estimated to be worth approximately ₹3,000 crore.

Among other approvals, the DAC cleared buy of Air-Ship Based High Altitude Pseudo Satellites for Air Force.

Focus on development of Rare Earth Corridor in State: Naidu to officials

CHIEF Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu has instructed senior officials to prepare comprehensive proposals for various development projects announced in the Union Budget 2026-27, with special emphasis on the Rare Earth Corridor to be set up in Srikakulam, Vizianagaram and Visakhapatnam districts.

At a review meeting held at his camp office on Thursday, the Chief Minister emphasised that all the departments should fully utilise funds allocated to Andhra Pradesh under the Centrally Sponsored Schemes to qualify for additional grants.

He pointed out that the previous regime had failed to spend sanctioned funds, leading to lapses in issuance of utility certificates, and instructed the officials to ensure proper spending on various development works, and compliance.

Naidu directed the departments to align the State development proposals with the Central schemes, and also take advantage of the newly introduced "challenge mode" funding mechanism.

He stressed the importance of planning strategically so that Andhra Pradesh secures

On infrastructure and transport, he stressed the need for effective use of the 1,000 electric buses sanctioned by the Centre for AP, and preparation of plans to secure more.

In agriculture, he highlighted the potential for higher allocations to coconut, cocoa, cashew, and coffee crops, while encouraging large-scale food processing projects.

Finally, Naidu underlined the scope for developing Tirupati as a major tourism destination in the State, reinforcing his vision of leveraging Central schemes to accelerate AP's industrial, technological, and agricultural growth.

EVERY time N. Chandrababu Naidu assumes office as Chief Minister, he introduces a distinct administrative focus and drives it consistently through his tenure.

Seattle to pay \$29 million to family of Indian student killed by police car

NEW YORK THE family of an Indian student, killed in January 2023 when she was struck by a police vehicle in Seattle, has reached a USD 29 million settlement with the city, according to a media report.

Kevin Dave as she was crossing a street on January 23, 2023. Dave was driving at 74 mph on the way to a report of a drug overdose call. Kandula was thrown 100 feet when she was struck by the speeding police patrol vehicle.

Jaahnavi Kandula's death was heartbreaking, and the city hopes this financial settlement brings some sense of closure to the Kandula family," city attorney Erika Evans said in the report.

In September 2024, the family brought a lawsuit against the City of Seattle and Dave for USD 110 million, as well as an additional USD 11,000.

remarks" made by Seattle Police Department officer Daniel Auderer. In their claim, filed in King County Superior Court, attorneys wrote that Kandula "experienced terror, severe emotional distress, and severe pain and suffering before dying."

said that she had fired Dave. Auderer was also fired following his insensitive comments and laughter after Kandula's death. Bodycam footage shows Auderer laughing after the fatal crash and saying the victim hit the car and "is dead," before laughing for four seconds, a disciplinary report said.

DHAKA BANGLADESH's deposed prime minister Sheikh Hasina on Thursday called the general elections being held by the interim government "a well-planned farce" and demanded holding of "free, fair and inclusive elections under a neutral caretaker government".



ing in India after she fled Bangladesh, said the elections being held under the interim government of Muhammad Yunus was essentially "a well-planned farce". "The people's voting rights, democratic values, and the spirit of the Constitution

were completely disregarded in this deceptive, voterless election conducted without the Awami League," she wrote on her party's social media. "From the evening of 11 February, this farce began with seizure of polling centres, gunfire, vote-buying, distribution of money, stamping of ballots, and agents signing result sheets," she alleged. Hasina claimed that by the morning of February 12, "voter turnout was negligible in most polling centres nationwide, and in many centres across the capital and other areas, there were no voters at all."

briefing, by 11 am - just three and a half hours into voting - only 14.96 per cent of eligible voters had participated," she said. This extremely low turnout clearly shows that the Awami League-free election was widely rejected by the people, Hasina said. Hasina said in the preceding days, "continuous attacks, arrests, intimidation, and fear were inflicted on Awami League voters, supporters, well-wishers, and minority communities". "Even so, despite threats and harassment, people rejected this fraudulent election, leaving most polling centres effectively empty," she said.

Two Israelis charged over bets using data

TWO Israelis have been charged with using classified military information to place bets on how future events will unfold, Israeli authorities said Thursday, accusing the individuals of "serious security offenses". A joint statement by the Israeli Ministry of Defense, domestic security service Shin Bet and police said that a civilian and a reservist are suspected of placing bets on the US-based prediction market Polymarket on military operations based on information that reservist had access to. Israel's Attorney General's Office decided to prosecute the two individuals following investigation by police.

China grips on earths as US builds alliance

BEIJING

CHINA has stepped up efforts to consolidate its monopoly over rare earth metals to counter the United States move to form an international alliance with over 50 nations, including India, to secure the supply chains of the precious metals to reduce reliance on Beijing. Early this week, Chinese Premier Li Qiang visited Ganzhou in Jiangxi province, one of the world's largest production bases for heavy rare earth elements, a strategic resource essential to a range of hi-tech industries, where he called for China to consolidate its lead in industries like rare earths, over which it has a strategic edge

over Washington. Li also visited the Chinese Academy of Sciences' Ganjiang Innovation Academy, toured critical mineral producers, and had a meeting with local business leaders and researchers, official media reported. "The value of rare earths in boosting advanced manufacturing and green, low-carbon transformation is increasingly prominent," he said. China's dominance of global mining and processing of the minerals has become a crucial strategic advantage in recent years, giving it vital leverage when sparring with the US. Li met producers of the critical minerals, local business leaders and researchers.

North Korea's evolving dynasty

SEOUL

SOUTH Korea's spy agency told lawmakers on Thursday that it believes the teenage daughter of North Korean leader Kim Jong Un is close to being designated as the country's future leader as he moves to extend the family dynasty to a fourth generation. The assessment by the National Intelligence Service comes as North Korea is preparing to hold its biggest political conference later this month, where Kim is expected to outline his major policy goals for the next five years and take steps to tighten his authoritarian grip. In a closed-door briefing, NIS officials said they are closely monitoring whether Kim's daughter — believed to be named Kim Ju Ae and around 13 years old — appears with him before thousands of delegates at the upcoming Workers' Party Congress, said lawmaker Lee Seong Kweun, who attended the meeting.

8. Bid Multiplier:
